






A Moment With BLESSING ISAAC

Blessing Isaac is a multifaceted individual: a singer, model/model manager, film producer, fashion designer, and stylist. Hailing from Akwa Ibom State, her interests include singing, dancing, meeting new people, and creating innovative projects. *In this interview, she took us on her journey in the modeling industry.*

HOW DID YOU START YOUR MODELING JOURNEY?

I started my career in modeling at a really young age. I really wanted to be a runway model; I loved seeing models walk and all of that. I also went for a modeling/acting competition, and that's where I finally learned how to catwalk. That competition made me realize my love for the entertainment industry, and even though... I didn't win the competition; I got to the Top 5. I felt like a winner because of all I had learned in that competition. Then I realized I always wanted to help young talents by introducing them to the entertainment world. I would always see people, walk up to them, and ask them if they were interested in modeling. If they were interested, I would send them job updates. It became a thing until I decided to actually start my own modeling agency.

WHAT ARE SOME CHALLENGES YOU HAVE FACED WHILE ESTABLISHING THE AGENCY?

I faced a lot of challenges running my modeling agency, especially at the beginning. Learning to coordinate models, especially the ones that are not very polite, and also the challenges of picking the...

right models to work with... little challenges here and there, but after a while, I was able to fix all of that.

WHAT ARE THE KEY FACTORS THAT SET YOUR AGENCY APART FROM OTHERS IN THE COMPETITIVE MODELING LANDSCAPE?

There are some unique things about my agency that some other agencies might not have:

- 1. The fact that my agency is like a family. When you see me and my models, you would feel like we are from the same family because of how we communicate with each other. I make everyone very comfortable around me but still set boundaries for business's sake.
- 2.1 work with very professional models. Some people say I have hacked this modeling agency thing because how is it that my models are always doing well on set? That's because I have been able to set strict rules that every model working with me has to abide by.

HOW DO YOU IDENTIFY PROMISING NEW TALENT FOR YOUR AGENCY?

When I want to pick a model for my agency, I first look at the face. The face is a model's selling point, in my opinion. You don't have to be the most beautiful, but your facial structure matters. Then physique is a plus, but what really matters to me is the model's mindset because, yes, you might have the best look... but not have the best brain if you know what I mean, and even though physical features are the first thing anyone would go for because, of course, you need a face that will sell the market, I believe every face has its own place and there is definitely a place for every model regardless of your looks. Whether tall or short, you have your own market. I'd also have conversations with the models; these conversations help me decide if I can work with them or not.

CAN YOU SHARE A SUCCESS STORY ABOUT A MODEL YOUR AGENCY HAS DEVELOPED?

Some models started their modeling careers from my modeling agency and are doing really well today. Some have even traveled outside the country for modeling gigs, and it makes me really happy because they were introduced to the industry by me.

WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS ON THE INFLUENCE OF SOCIAL MEDIA ON MODELING CAREERS TODAY?

Social media can make or break a model's career, and I will explain what I mean by this. There is a certain kind of pressure models have when they are on social media seeking validation from people who do not really understand what modeling really means. You see how people expect you to look a certain way because a certain popular model looks that way. You see models changing their look to fit a certain image just because they want to meet the "social media standard." That is so wrong.

No here is how social media can make a model, having a social media page where you have your pictures and jobs you have done helps people see you and know what you are capable of doing as a model. It also you connect with helps other models around the world and that networking is something every model needs. You also get to see what your favorite role models are up to and learn while from them still learning to be unique with your craft.

The advice I would give any aspiring model is, JUST BE YOU, BE YOURSELF, TRUST YOUR PROCESS, and LOVE YOURSELF ENOUGH.




