## 7 STYLING TIPS FOR CURVE MODELS

**W**ith the modelling industry adapting and changing every day, the demand for curve models is increasing. The “body positivity” movement has prompted agencies and industry to start to embrace bodies of all shapes and sizes. Therefore, everyone has a chance to celebrate their bodies, both in and out of the industry!

With the curve modelling sector growing and changing, so is the clothing industry and people are becoming a lot more aware of what clothing suits their body type.

### 1. ENSURE YOU GET YOUR SIZING RIGHT

It is important to wear the “right size” clothing. Try avoiding wearing sizes that are too small for the body, as it accentuates the wrong areas. On the other hand, wearing loose clothes can make you give a wrong impression of your overall body structure and sizing.

The better the sizing, the more flattering it looks. That being said, when shopping feels free to try out different sizes of clothes, as a lot of brands are known to have different clothing sizes under the universal size numbers.

### 2. DEFINE YOUR WAIST

Cinching waists helps to project a slimmer waistline and provides an hourglass figure. It is recommended to wear high waist belts for shorter people, as it will elongate their overall appearances and make their legs look longer. Tuck the belts with loose fitted fabric to avoid the “bulging effect”. Avoid wearing thick belts as it can bring attention to the width of a person, which completely defeats the purpose of the cinched effect.

### 3. AVOID ROUNDED TOE SHOES

Often rounded shoes can have the impact of making anyone look shorter. A look overall can be elongated by wearing pointed or open toe shoes. This will make the legs look longer and well-balanced.

### 4. UTILIZE STRATEGIC PATTERNS

Patterns can be a tricky matter when it comes to balancing an overall look. Bold colored, thick patterns can give the impression of a different body size and can bring attention to the wrong body parts. Whereas, smaller and darker colored patterns can complement the style and the form. For example, smaller polka dots can make the figure look a lot more flattering than bigger ones.

### 5. V NECKS ARE THE BEST

V neck tops can elongate the appearance of the waist. V neck tops can help direct focus from any problematic area to the bust area. This can also make the look more feminine and playful.

### 6. HIGH WAIST BOTTOMS COMPLIMENT ANYONE'S FIGURE!

High waist pants or skirts with pointed or open-toe shoes are often great pairs that elongate the look, beautifully. To complete the look, wear a semi-fitted top which ends on the waistline if not slightly under.

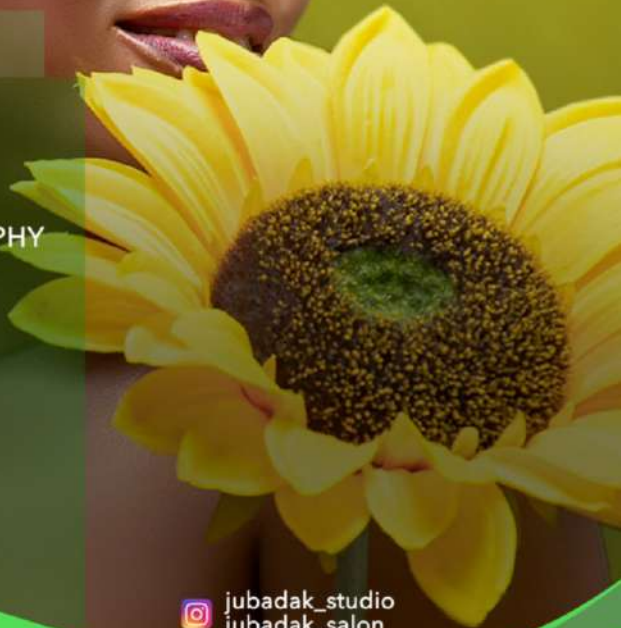

**H**ilda Effiong Bassey (born 20 September 1996), better known as Hilda Baci, is a Nigerian chef, restaurateur, actress, and the current holder of the Guinness World Record for marathon cooking (Cook-athon) with 93 hours 11 minutes, setting a new record after surpassing Indian chef Lata

Tondon 87 hours, 45 minutes cooking marathon in 2023.

Hilda was born on 20 September 1996, and she is from the Nsit Ubium Local Government Area of Akwa Ibom State. She graduated with a degree in sociology from Madonna University, located in Okija, River State. She was the host of Dine on a Budget, a television shows that airs on Pop Central TV.

Baci embarked on a culinary education program, drawing inspiration from her mother, a culinary chef. Hilda broke the record for longest cooking marathon by any individual hitting 87 hours 50 minutes above the previous record holder in 2019.

Guinness World Records has officially confirmed that Nigerian chef and restaurateur Hilda Baci has broken the record for the longest cooking marathon (individual) with a time of 93 hours and 11 minutes.

"Almost seven hours were deducted from her final total because she mistakenly took extra minutes for one of her rest breaks early on in the attempt."

### TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF

Well, am Prince Ikechukwu Miraculous Diji by name, am Onicha Olona in Aniocha North local government, Delta State. Am married with three girls.

Am the CEO of RWEP-MID NIGERIA COMPANY, Moderator for Models Association, Delta State coordinator for Pageant Guild of Nigeria and currently the Chairman Board of Directors for RWEP MID FILMS AND MEDIA ACADEMY. A private polytechnic. Am an entertainer, complete production personnel.

My primary school is Holy Child Nursery and Primary School,

with the position of Head Boy and later went to Boys Model Secondary School where I was the Social Prefect. I read Mass Communication in Ogwashi Uku where I was the Social Director and later studied a professional course in Film and Television Production.

After I graduated, I shot couple of Films and Directed Some of music videos and train some artists like Mac P, Emmy Brown, Patomant who performed alongside popular and famous Davido on stage and so many others. A lot that has been done anyway, I can go on and on.

### WHAT IS THE MOTIVATION AND IDEA BEHIND RWEP MID FILMS AND MEDIA ACADEMY?

Oh beautiful, let me start by saying RWEP MID NIGERIA COMPANY has a lot to do, we are into human capital development and we set up platforms for gifted and talented citizens to get self-employed. We equally build surviving and lasting content programs for both, television and radio stations. We shoot quality movies, event coverage and Management, record both still and motion pictures, train musical artists and as well train people in our various fields of engagements.

So having all these things to the company, I felt the last part of my engagement which is training should spring up and since we are into human capital development, I decided to give that to the society by the training and get them certified with a National Diploma Certificate.

Apart from that, I noticed that getting a job has become a thing of story for the gods, so with a practical based course, people can be self-employed to employ others.

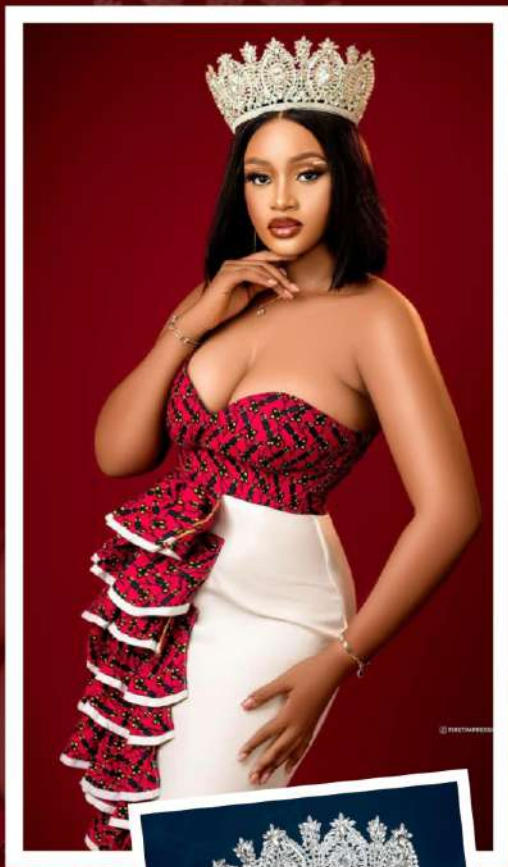

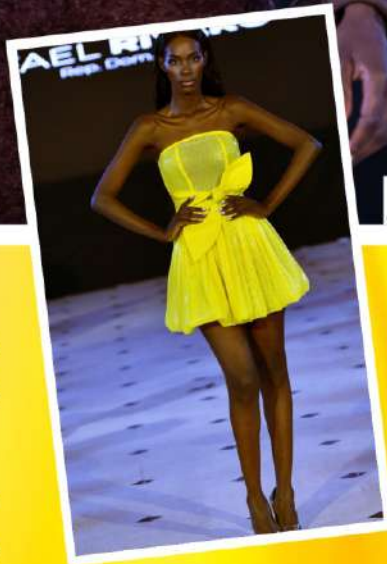

**WHAT IS THE BIGGEST MODELING JOB YOU HAVE DONE SO FAR?**

I consider every opportunity i get big because I learn new things every day. I used to focus on well-known brands, but i have realized that everyone deserves a chance. All those big brands we worship both started as these small ones. This kind of thinking is the reason why many graduates are jobless. Every company wants experienced workers, yet no one wants to give them a chance to gain that experience.

**LOOKING BACK AT HOW YOU STARTED, WHAT WOULD YOU SAY STOOD YOU OUT IN YOUR CAREER?**

Being myself, i am always myself, i know how imperfect i am, and i have accepted



it. I don't want to be perfect, and i don't compete with anyone other than myself.

**HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOUR PERSONAL STYLE?**

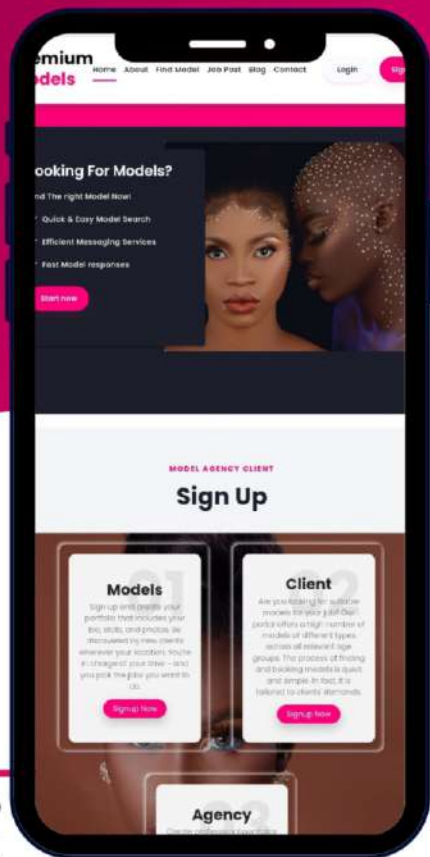
