





WHICH BRANDS ARE YOU LOOKING **FORWARD TO WORK WITH?**


I have non in mind now but I will do my best where ever I Find my self

Now that we have known what goal setting is, lets go ahead and explain in terms the word 'Smart'.


- Specific: Here you have identified and defined the goal, you must be exact since you already know what you want.







Hear the Bible: "For the father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgement unto the son, that all men should honor the son, even as they honor the father. He who

honoureth not the son, honoureth not the Father who hath sent Him" (John 5:22-23). Now If you say you don't need Jesus, do you know what you are saying? You are dishonoring God the Father. That is why the Bible says in john 3:18 "He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already for hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God".

I have good news for you, however, you can move from condemnation to life, for the bible says again; "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the spirit. For the law in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death" (Romans 8:1-2) which means: it is impossible to be free from sin and eternal death by our own efforts.


Only Jesus can make it possible because operational in Him is a law – the law of the spirit of life. This is superior to the destructive law of sin and death. How does the law of the spirit of life operate? First, it shows you (as this leaflet is doing), that Jesus is the one who is the way, the truth and the life. (John 14:6).

Secondly, it makes you realize that you are a sinner who needs help, for the bible says, "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God" and "if we say have not sinned there is no truth in us" (Roman 3:23, 1 John 10:10). Thirdly, it shows you God's plan for salvation (see Roman 5:6-10). Fourth, it leaves you with the option to choose Jesus and live, or the devil and die (John 10:10).

What is your relationship with Jesus? He has paid the price of your redemption. Why then will you die in your sins? Choose you this day whom you will serve – God or the devil? All that he is asking you to do is realize that you are a sinner, confess your sins to Jesus, and ask Him to be merciful unto you. Then invite him personally into your heart as Lord and savior (Proverbs 28:13). If you sincerely do this, then you will be brought into personal relationship with Christ (John 1:12). Do it today. Don't delay. Tomorrow might be too late.
