
## LASTLY, ANY MESSAGE FOR THE ASPIRING GIRLS WHO DREAM OF WINNING A BEAUTY CONTEST

To start this Internet business in Nigeria was a challenge, as it is a very hard to do business in Sub-Saharan Africa. So who is the person, who managed to make his dream company shine bright? Let's find out who is PayPorte owner and learn more about his success story.

The path to success: Eyo Bassey His name is Eyo Bassey Francis and he is the CEO of the fastest developing Internet Company in Nigeria - PayPorte Global Systems. Eyo loves to study. He is an alumnus of the prestigious MIT and a London Business School graduate. He also took some courses at Harvard. His career started right after his graduation from Ladoke Akintola University of Technology (LAUTECH). He did his major in Pure and Applied Physics but always wanted to work in IT sector. The Applied Physics is very close to the IT sector and Eyo always felt that his future will be connected with IT. He also mentioned that even before going to the school, he had been hired by people to surf the web. Slowly, he learned how to write code and found his way in software development. In addition, he also had his own role models, who really inspired him to engage deeply with the IT sector. But most of all, his family was a great support to him. They gave him a computer on his 17th birthday, which might have been his first step in software development.

Soon after the graduation, he started to work in a company, called Socket Works Global. He was the Global Systems Administrator, but after a while, he was promoted to the position of Head of Software Engineering. Eyo gained valuable experience and learned a lot of useful things in the company, but eventually decided to move on. He wanted to build his own business. Eyo often says that the entrepreneurial instinct is probably in his blood. When he was 11 years old, he lost his dad and since he was the eldest out of 5 kids in the family, Eyo had the most responsibility. At that time, facing a lot of challenges, he even helped friends with street business make some money.

However, Eyo believes that he was not born with the entrepreneurial instinct: "Maybe it also could have been passed down to me from my dad. My dad also worked for himself until he passed on. I think the challenges of life also helped form me into this path. So I wouldn't say I was born an entrepreneur but rather, I have this great entrepreneurial spirit in me.

Basically, Eyo organized the whole management system in the company. The unplanned PayPorte The company was launched on the 25th of September, 2014 and is now considered to be one of the most inspiring projects by Eyo. PayPorte is e-commerce website. Here you can find both electronic and tech appliances and variety of daily products, such as fabrics home appliances, furniture and others. In 2016, PayPorte opened the 1k store, the first of its kind in its industry, which was able to support the customers through the economic downturn.

These days, the PayPorte company is a successful, Nigerian domestic-owned company. The funding for the company's development was received from other projects by Eyo and through different consulting services. This means that there is no additional investor other than Eyo. My mom is my role model, she's a virtuous woman, very courageous and helps in a way she can.





# 7 STEPS ON HOW TO GET A MODEL BODY

Models are immediately assumed to be stick thin, very tall, size zero creatures who "no one looks like". However, there are different types of models, with various body types. Whatever body type you are looking to get, it is achievable based on your natural figure and your endurance.

- Decide what type of body you want. Typically, for someone aspiring to be, or to look like a high fashion model, you have to be at least 1.72m, and considerably slim. Plus size models are fuller and more curvaceous, and swimsuit and underwear models are thin but with curves.
- Take your current stats and measurements. You want to be able to have something to compare with, sort of like a before and after thing. Measure your weight, hips, bust, and waist; know your dress size etc. You can also take some pictures if you want. This encourages you as you go on and helps you determine your rate of progress.
- Make diet plans. You might need to lose, or gain, a bit
  of weight to get the body you want. See a nutritionist,
  go online, ask around, and get a diet plan that will help
  you put on, get rid of, or maintain the weight you
  desire.
- 4. Make a regular workout plan. Every type of model needs to work out and stay in shape in order to look good and remain healthy. Go to a gym near you, get a personal trainer and tell him/her what you want. You can also work out on your own at home, but whatever you do make sure you get regular cardio (you can get this through activities like dancing, and some sports like boxing, table tennis), and you tone your body. Cardio gets your heart rate up and

develops muscles, while toning shapes the muscles to give you a sleek and sexy shape. If you need to work on a particular area of your body, do so, but do not forget that you have to exercise your whole body as well to stay in good shape. Make sure you work out regularly, and often, to get results.

- 5. Take care of your skin and hair. Models have great skin and lovely hair. Take care of yours by eating lots of fruits, and drinking lots of water. Avoid foods with lots of fats or oil as this make the skin oily and gives pimples (zits). Do not use soaps and lotions that are harsh on your skin; avoid prolonged exposure to the sun. Any scars you wish to get rid of? See a dermatologist, as whatever treatment you get is particular to the skin type you have.
- 6. Stick to your plan. This is always the most difficult part. You have to stick to your diet and exercise regularly. You can put up pictures of the body you're aiming for to inspire you. One thing you should always do is visualize yourself with that body. It generally makes things easier, and helps you see your body changes faster.
- 7. Get someone else involved. We tend to strive to achieve things faster when we know people are watching. Tell a friend or family member, several if you want to, about your plans. It should preferably be someone who sees you often, so that you don't just lie to the person through the phone.





THAT BLOOD BATH IN PLATEAU, BENUE AND OTHER PARTS OF NIGERIA

he intensity of the barbaric killings in Nigeria by the Fulani herdsmen seems to have quietened, but certainly not quenched. Theirmomentary silence is damming suspicious, and most likely not unconnected to the current political game of "camping and decamping" in the Country. We must not be distracted by this game to forget how the fundamental duties of governancehave been ignored, and the lives of innocent Nigerians put at risk.

The Catholic moral and social teachings unequivocally proclaims the sacredness of human life and the dignity of the human person, but these have been threatened in our dear country by the almost legalization of the unaccustomed killings that recently took the centre stage in our dear nation. From thousands of kilometres and across the ocean you hear the cry of the people and see their blood being poured out like libation. From Plateau, Benue, Kaduna to Enugu states, the land is soaked, unable to quaff anymore blood. This reminds one of the voice of lamentation and bitter weeping that was heard in Ramah, "Rachel is weeping for her children; she refuses to be comforted for her children, because they are no more." Jer. 33: 15.

This is shameful. It makes many Nigerians in diaspora ashamed to be identified as Nigerians among their counterparts who daily boast of breakthroughs in different fields: medical, technology, economics and in manyother areas where they have exceptionally grown as a nation; not leaving out the great respect for human rights. These Nigerians are ashamed not because they got no talents but because, the chaotic, greedy and visionless style of leadership in Nigeria ostracized them and water down their zeal to build a country they would have proudly called their own.

The loud silence of our leaders about the Fulani herdsmen rampage is worrisome and a dangerous trend that may signify the gradual ebb of a nation from what holds her together. The strong but ignored question keeps resounding: Will Nigeria exist beyond 2019? I pray it does because; our unity in diversity is priceless. But the hostility of the blood thirsty Fulani herdsmen around the ccountry and the pretentious voices of condemnation of their actions coming from under the same canopy that covers the killer herdsmen from the heat of the law are all threatening the foundation of this unity.

Although I cannot completely hold this administration responsible for every killing in Nigeria, it has however shown a disgraceful sense of irresponsibility. The promised change seems to be realisable only through human sacrifices; their political ambition is worth human blood, and the jihadist style of attack seems to be a working tool. The mayhem uninterruptedly dished out in Plateau State and in many other parts of Nigeria by the Fulani herdsmen indicates a failed nation that has been dragged into a state of anarchy. I may be a very young Nigerian, but certainly not too young not to have had a little of the good old days. I vividly recollect how the now killer herdsmen tended their flock and peacefully

and freely walked in and around their 0 s communities. They proudly hanged their shepherd's staff over their shoulders and lived their nomadic life with no religious intolerance. How then did



these people metamorphose into a terrorist group? Yes, they are terrorists even though this administration has refused to acknowledge that fact. How did the shepherd's staff moved from the shoulders to become Ak47 in their hands? Who taught the Fulani herdsmen how to professionally handle an Ak47? How did he get it? These pertinent questions expose the reality of the selfishness and wickedness of many of our leaders who believe that their political ambition is more important than human lives.

I certainly do not excuse the insensitive and cruelty of the killer-herdsmen, but our leaders should be held responsible for the incessant killings across the nation. They have used poverty, illiteracy and religion as their instrument of manipulations to create animosity between those who once lived in peace. Like some very dangerous chemical combinations, they have combined their strong political ambitions with their religious fanaticism to transform themselves into angry "gods" who are out to wipe the so-called unbelievers and political enemies.

The killer-herdsmen would not have the confidence to move into an area faraway from their settlement to maim and kill innocent citizens uninterrupted if they were not politically backed. To deny this fact is to tell the whole world how dysmally weak our policing, military strength and intelligence-gathering have become. But I know we have the best of these; it is either they willingly co-operate with these killers or are incapacitated by the "Oga at the top" for religious and political reasons.

I never doubted the political motives behind these killings, and connecting it to ethnic cleansing is not an exaggeration of the situation.

Nigerians and Christians in particular are tired of presidential visits and condolences, we need protection; it is our right to be protected. This government belongs to everybody and to no body, as the President Muhammadu Buhari once said.
